Bug Hotels!



You will need...

- 1 empty plastic bottle or milk carton
 - String
 - Scissors
 - Pair of tights

- Lots of natural things to make your bug hotel with e.g. sticks, long grass, flowers, pinecones



1. Wash and dry your bottle out and remove all labels, take off the bottle lid (you do not need this). Ask an adult to cut a rectangle shape out from one side of the bottle.
2. Add your string through the bottle and tie so you can hang it up when it is finished.
3. Carefully place all your natural materials in the bottle. Start with the rocks and then use the grass twigs and leaves to make a home for all the bugs.
4. Next carefully cut a piece from the tights bigger than the hole you cut and glue or tape over the top.
5. Then wait for the bugs to check in. Check your bug hotel every day and take note of any new arrivals.
