



Blended Learning Plan

St Michael's remote learning plan aims to blend face-to face learning and remote learning, so no child falls behind, by offering high quality, well sequenced teaching and learning, reflecting in-school provision.

In the event that your child needs to isolate from home:

- There is an expectation that schoolwork is completed at home and returned to the class teacher.
- Your child will receive their class timetable and an exercise book.
- Your child's lessons will follow the same structure of that in school and will follow their class timetable. This will include a daily Maths, English and a foundation subject (Religious Education, Science, Humanities, Physical Education, Design and Technology/ Art and Design/ Music and French) lesson. If your child is in Early Years or Key Stage One, they will also complete a daily phonics activity.
- Your child's class teacher will upload the activities every morning to Seesaw.
- Your child should complete the activities and send them back to the teacher via the Seesaw app.
- The teacher will mark the work and give feedback. This will help your child to further improve.
- Your child will be asked to complete a combination of practical, online and written activities. These can be uploaded direct to Seesaw or via video or photograph.
- If your child is ill, then they would not be expected to complete the work. However, parents should inform school when they are better and would, under normal circumstance, return to school.
- Your child's class teacher or teaching assistant will be in contact via telephone on a weekly basis.
- As well as the lesson on Seesaw, your child will have the opportunity to participate in one live Maths and English lesson via Zoom per week. The link for this lesson will be shared in advance on Seesaw.



How much work is my child expected to complete?

- 1 daily Maths lesson
- 1 daily English lesson
- 1 daily Foundation subject lesson

How will the class teacher support my child's learning at home?

- Lessons will be shared on Seesaw via videos, PowerPoints, written tasks and activities.
- Your child's class teacher will give daily feedback via Seesaw.
- Your child will be invited to take part in two small group lessons on Zoom with their class teacher. The Zoom link will be shared in advance on Seesaw.
- The class teacher and teaching assistant will contact your child via telephone on a weekly basis.

What if me or my child has a problem or needs to speak to the teacher?

- You or your child can ask for help via Seesaw.
- You can contact the school office and a message will be passed directly onto the class teacher.
- If you are entitled to means tested free school meals, packed lunches can be delivered to your home if they are needed.
- If you need support with your child's behaviour or are concerned about their mental health, please contact the school office and ask to speak to Mrs Chapman or Miss Consterdine.

What if I can't access Seesaw when my child is at home?

- If you cannot access Seesaw for whatever reason, please contact the school office so they will inform the class teacher.
- If you do not have access to a device to access remote learning, please contact the school office. St Michael's will endeavor to support all pupils with an appropriate device.
- There is also the option of schoolwork being shared via email or as a paper copy.
